Although the highest standards of democracy remain unrealized, they nonetheless pose a Universal Problem of Good Government in a Democracy. Constitutionalism involves tension between power in government required to maintain order among the people and limits on power to prevent government from unjustly denying liberty to the people. The government cannot, for example, restrain in advance what a newspaper may print.
