The sonnet is a strange one, moving from great tenderness at the beginning to almost dramatic contempt Holy Sonnet 17 the end. It is probably the most autobiographical of the sonnets, detailing the effect of his wife's early death, especially in driving him closer to God. Historian Gregg Herken believes that Oppenheimer named the site in reference to Donne's poetry as a tribute to his deceased mistress, psychiatrist and physician Jean Tatlock – the daughter of an English literature professor and philologist—who introduced Oppenheimer to the works of Donne.
